

ORDINANCE NO. 1086

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9.30 OF THE FAIRFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE: TO PROVIDE FOR VENDOR PERMIT LICENSE REGULATIONS FOR SPECIAL EVENTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF FAIRFIELD, IOWA:

Section 1. SUBSTITUTING AMENDMENT. Fairfield Municipal Code Chapter 9.30.190 is HEREBY ADDED BY INSERTION of the following:

Any direct seller, peddler, person, solicitor or transient merchant must obtain a license from the city administrator or his designee and pay the appropriate fee(s) as provided in this chapter to be allowed to conduct business during any Fairfield 1st Friday Artwalk events.

Each vendor must provide the following:

1. Name, permanent address and tax identification number or drivers license
2. Name, address and phone number of the firm, corporation, partnership or association for whom applicant is conducting business
3. Iowa sales tax number (if appropriate)
4. Date/dates when proposed license is desired
5. Make, model, year, license number and state of registration of any vehicle being used in connection with said business
6. Description of products and merchandise being sold
7. Not-for-profit companies must provide 501 c3 tax exemption form
8. All vendors must conform to all Federal, State and Local laws.

Regulations

1. Only businesses on the square with direct access to the street to sell their own products will be excluded from license process. This waiver would only include businesses selling products within their normal scope of business.
2. The Vendor Fee for a weekend license is forty dollars (\$40)
3. Side Walk musicians must also obtain a no fee license.
4. All other business owners on the second floor of buildings and in the back of a building would be allowed a dedicated area for set up at a 50% rate due to their proximity to the storefront sidewalks.

The foregoing ordinance was adopted by the City Council of the City of Fairfield, Iowa at its regular meeting held on the 29TH day of May, AD, 2012 upon a motion by Councilperson Revolinski and seconded by Councilperson Hamilton.


