

## City Ordinance

FAIRFIELD, Iowa – ORDINANCE NO. 1103A

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD, IOWA ENACTED TO ASSIST CITY OFFICIALS AND THE RAGBRAI COMMITTEE DEAL WITH THE PUBLIC SAFETY ISSUES CREATED BY THE INFUSION OF A LARGE NUMBER OF PEOPLE INTO THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD WHEN THE DES MOINES REGISTER'S ANNUAL GREAT BICYCLE RIDE ACROSS IOWA (RAGBRAI) ARRIVES IN FAIRFIELD ON JULY 26, 2103, AND DEPARTS ON JULY 27, 2103.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD, IOWA:

Section I. The Municipal Code of the City of Fairfield, Iowa be amended by the following Ordinance designated "RAGBRAI ORDINANCE II", which because of its temporary nature shall not be printed as part of the permanent Code of Ordinances. The RAGBRAI Ordinance is as follows:

### Section I. Definitions.

- A. As used herein, "temporary stop sign", shall include any stop sign installed to assist with traffic flow in areas not designated by city ordinance or is being converted from a 2 way to 4 way designation.
- B. Locations:
  - 1. Highway 1 & Fillmore Avenue – 4 way.
  - 2. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street & Fillmore – 4 way.
  - 3. 5<sup>th</sup> Street & Fillmore – 4 way.
  - 4. 6<sup>th</sup> Street & Fillmore – 4 way.
  - 5. Burlington Avenue & Fairgrounds east entrance - 4 way.
  - 6. 28<sup>th</sup> & Burlington (Fairground gravel entrance) – 4 way.
  - 7. 32<sup>nd</sup> Street & Burlington Avenue – 4 way.

### Section 2. Effective.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be in effect from 6:00 a.m. on July 26, 2013 to 12:00 p.m. on July 27, 2013.

### Section 3. Authority.

Any and all issue and appeals regarding this ordinance will be brought to the local RAGBRAI Committee and the City of Fairfield for resolution.

Section II. All previous ordinances or parts of such ordinances in conflict with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section III. If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any section thereof, or part thereof, not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section IV. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


