ORDINANCE NO. 1115

AN ORDINANCE AMEMDING AND SUPPLEMENTING FAIRFIELD'S SIGN ORDINANCE OF THE FAIRFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE BY SPECIFICALLY REFERENCING POLE SIGNS AND MONUMENT SIGNS UNDER GENERAL SIGN REGULATION AND PROVIDING DEFINITION FOR EACH WITHIN NEW SUBSECTIONS (10) AND (11).

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF FAIRFIELD, IOWA THAT:

SECTION 1. Amendment. The Fairfield Municipal Code of Ordinances Chapter 20.76.020 is **HEREBY AMENDED BY ADDITION AND INSERTION** of the following immediately following Chapter 20.76.020(9)(k).

"20.76.020(10) Monument or Ground Sign. A monument sign or ground sign is an on premises free-standing sign with the appearance of a solid base. It is ordinarily directly and permanently supported from within; and is physically separated from any other structure, and is installed directly on the ground and not attached to any other structure or building. Monument or Ground Signs are subject to other limitations of the Municipal Sign Ordinance contained at Chapter 20.76 and shall be limited to no greater than fifteen (15) feet in height."

AND:

"20.76.020(11) <u>Pole Sign.</u> A pole sign is a sign erected on a free-standing frame, mast, or pole, on premises, with a clearance greater than three (3) feet. The same may be attached to a structure. Ordinarily the same would be part of a completely self-supporting structure. Such self-supporting structure shall be firmly installed in or below ground surface and not attached to any other structure, whether portable, or stationary. Pole Signs are subject to other limitations of the Municipal Sign Ordinance contained at Chapter 20.76 and shall be limited to no greater than thirty-five (35) feet in height."

SECTION 2. Severability Clause. If any of the provisions of this ordinance are for any reason illegal or void, then the lawful provisions of this document, which are separable from the unlawful provision shall be and remain in full force and effect, the same as if the ordinance contained no illegal or void provisions.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in effect sixty (60) days after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
