## ORDINANCE NO. 1154

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 645 AND SECTION 20.16.030 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD, IOWA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Fairfield, Iowa:

SECTION I. The Zoning and District Map dated March 26, 1996 and referred to in Section 20.16.030 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fairfield, Iowa, is hereby changed and amended in the following respects:

(a) The following described territory within the corporate limits of the City of Fairfield, Iowa, is hereby changed from M-2 General Manufacturing District to B-1 General Business District:

Lots Three (3), Four (4), Five (5) and Six (6) and the alley lying between Lots One (1), Two (2) and Three (3) on the East and Lots Four (4), Five (5), and Six (6) on the West in Block Six (6) of Henn's Sub-division of Blocks Five (5) and Six (6) of Henn, Williams & Company's Addition to the City of Fairfield, Jefferson County, Iowa.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after adoption and publication as required by law.
