REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION

- 1) The City of Fairfield Ways and Means Committee consider applications during the month of January. All applications must be received by 4 pm on the second Friday of January. No applications received after this time will be accepted or considered.
- 2) Previous recipients of LOST funds within the last 5 years, must report and account for their use of funds in writing as part of the application.
- 3) Only applicants that qualify as a 501 (c) 3 will be eligible to apply.
- 4) Application requests must be for Fairfield community betterment.
- 5) Each application will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
- 6) No requests for political causes, candidates, organizations or campaigns will be considered.
- 7) No requests from religious organizations, unless the particular program will benefit a large portion of the community without regard to religious affiliation and does not duplicate the work of other agencies in the community.
- 8) All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their requests by April 30th.
- 9) Approved requests will be distributed funds after a written request of funds is submitted to the Office of the City Clerk, after July 1.
